

### BACKGROUND

**HWPL** is an international organization headquartered in Seoul Republic of Korea in association with United Nations Economic and Social Council and United Nations Department of Global Communications. HWPL have 3 main initiatives:

- 1) Establishment of international law for peace based on the DPCW;
- 2) Inter-faith/inter-religious dialogues for harmony, and;
- 3) Peace education for spreading the culture of peace.

January 24th HWPL Day of Peace in Philippines

For this noble work above, Chairman Man Hee Lee, the founder of HWPL, travelled the world 31 times from 2013 to 2019 reaching out current and former heads of states, political and religious leaders, youth and women representatives, and people from education sector.

He visited the Philippines more than 8 times and contribute to the peace building efforts in Mindanao starting with the January 24, 2014 Mindanao Peace Agreement between Gov. Esmael Mangudadatu and Archbishop Fernando Capalla. This symbolizes the beginning of spreading HWPL's peace initiatives throughout Mindanao, and eventually, the entire Philippines.

In January 2015 the 1st commemoration of this peace agreement, January 24th was declared by the Province of Maguindanao as HWPL Day of Peace and established the 1st HWPL peace monument in the Buluan, Maguindanao, Philippines.

Continuously spreading HWPL's peace initiative in Mindanao, the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF), through the leadership of Chairman Al-Haj Murad Ebrahim who is now the Chief Minister of BARMM, established the 2nd HWPL peace monument in Camp Darapanan and also declared January 24th as HWPL Day of Peace.

Since then, January 24 became a significant day for the global family of peace of HWPL. Meanwhile, the local government of Davao City, Cotabato City, and Kapalong Davao del Norte released a resolution expressing their strong support for HWPL's Declaration of Peace and Cessation of War (DPCW)

Furthermore, the United Nations General Assembly adopted a resolution on December 3, 2018 proclaiming January 24 as International Day of Education, in celebration of the role of education for bringing global peace and sustainable development.









## **CONCEPT NOTE**

#### OVERVIEW

#### 7th Anniversary of the January 24 HWPL Peace Day

Chairman Man Hee Lee, the founder of HWPL, travelled the world 31 times from 2013 to 2019 reaching out current and former heads of states, political and religious leaders, youth and women representatives, and people from the field of education. He visited the Philippines more than 8 times and contributed to the peace building efforts in Mindanao starting with the January 24, 2014 Mindanao Peace Agreement between Gov. Esmael Mangudadatu and Archbishop Fernando Capalla. This symbolizes the beginning of spreading HWPL's peace initiatives throughout Mindanao, and eventually, across the entire country of the Philippines.

In January 2015, to commemorate the 1st anniversary of this peace agreement, January 24th was declared by the Province of Maguindanao as the HWPL Day of Peace and the 1st HWPL peace monument was established in Buluan, Maguindanao, Philippines.

In order to continuously spread HWPL's peace initiatives across Mindanao, the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF), through the leadership of Chairman Al-Haj Murad Ebrahim who is now the Chief Minister of BARMM, established the 2nd HWPL peace monument in Camp Darapanan and confirmed January 24th as the HWPL Day of Peace. Since then, January 24th became a significant day for the global family of peace of HWPL.

A milestone in peace education was achieved when a partnership between HWPL and the Commission on Higher Education was forged on January 23, 2018 through Dr. Ronald L. Adamat. Immediately after that year, CHED Memorandum Order no. 1 series of 2019 was issued mandating all Higher Educational Institutions to integrate peace education in their respective curricula.

In addition, the United Nations General Assembly adopted a resolution on December 3, 2018 proclaiming January 24th as the International Day of Education, in celebration of the role of education in bringing global peace and sustainable development.

#### **PURPOSE**

HWPL is carrying out various activities and educations to raise awareness of peace in cooperation with the government, the educational sector, the youth, and women's organizations in order to leave the world of sustainable peace as a legacy for future generations. Among them, the Peace Agreement in Mindanao, Philippines that was made on January 24, 2014 is of great value in promoting the spirit of peace as it is the historic moment of bringing together the hearts of all citizens who wanted peace and ending nearly 50 years of conflict in the area. Therefore, through an event celebrating the 7th anniversary of this groundbreaking achievement, we aim to raise awareness around the world of the Day of Peace that is celebrated every year on January 24th. It will be an opportunity to renew the hope and spirit of peace among people around the world who are currently experiencing various violence and conflicts, especially since the onset of COVID 19. At this event, we will share success stories of peaceful dispute resolution through the process of restoring peace in Mindanao. Following this, examples of spreading the culture of peace in various countries will be shared through keynote speeches and collective pledges will be made by participants. We will focus on spreading the culture of peace through HWPL peace education in each country.
