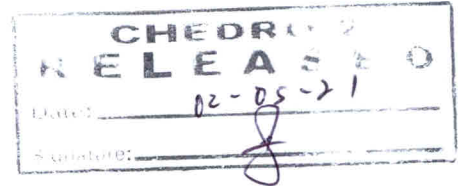

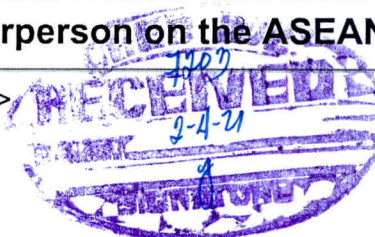

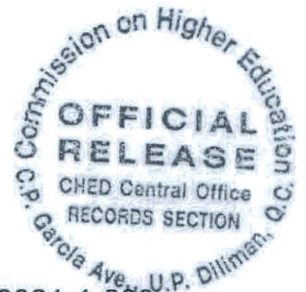

1st half of June	Convening of the ASEAN Prize 2021 Judging Committee Meeting, chaired by the ASEAN Secretary-General
1st week August	Awarding Ceremony for both ASEAN Prize 2020 Recipient and ASEAN Prize 2021 Recipient at the 54 th ASEAN Foreign Ministers' Meeting in Bandar Seri Begawan, Brunei Darussalam
