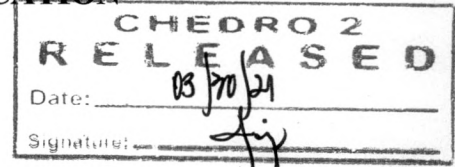

As part of the joint initiatives of the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Department of Health (DOH) through the Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) 2021-001, and pursuant to the Inter-Agency Task Force on the Management of Emerging and Infectious Diseases (IATF) Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines with its Amendments on the gradual re-opening of higher education institutions through limited face-to-face classes, the Commission on Higher Education Regional Office 2 will be hosting a webinar through the **Progressive Webinar Series** with the topics **“Getting ready for the limited face-to-face classes and Balik Eskwela Na, Paano Na Kaya?”** on **April 7, 2021 at 1:00 in the afternoon via Zoom and Facebook live.**

The said webinar is part of the series of continuous conduct of dialogues with Higher Education Institutions and students under the concept of #KAMALAYAN Progressive Webinar Series which are hosted by various CHED Regional Offices in the country.

The webinar generally aims to prepare the participants for the face-to-face classes with the following specific objectives:

1. To support the students in preparation for the face-to-face class through recognizing the role of stress, effective coping and positive psychology in their psychological well-being.
2. To discover experiences of the students and relate insights for possible coping mechanism in their day-to-day undertakings as they face the challenges of the new normal.

The participants to this activity are the Deans/Heads/Directors/Chiefs of the Student Affairs and Services and all students of Higher Education Institutions in Region 2. However, due to the limited capacity of the zoom, only five (5) student participants per HEIs shall join the webinar through the zoom, preferably officers of student organizations and/or student government.
