<u>Call for Application: SHARE Graduate Employability in ASEAN - The Contribution of Student Mobility Research Report</u>

The Support to Higher Education in the ASEAN Region (SHARE) Programme is the European Union's flagship higher education programme with ASEAN. The SHARE Programme has been in operation since 2015. An agreement between the European Commission and the ASEAN Secretariat has extended the Programme up to the end of December 2022. The SHARE Extension will see the programme continue its support of the ASEAN Secretariat and ASEAN stakeholders to enable greater harmonization and internationalization of ASEAN higher education. A central aim of the SHARE Programme Extension is to catalyze the transfer of ownership of programme outcomes to ASEAN entities and nominated organizations to be embedded within sustainable ASEAN-led structures and processes.

As the technical lead for Result Area 2a – Qualifications Frameworks of SHARE's programme implementation, the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) is seeking a team of researchers to conduct a qualitative study and compile a research report on graduate employability following intra-ASEAN mobility periods. The tender is particularly for the provision of one Financial Expert and one Operations Evaluation Expert.

The envisaged ASEAN Aid is a public donation-based fund and a strategic communication tool that seeks to engage ASEAN citizens, communities, and private sectors to contribute to the work of ASEAN. Through the ASEAN Aid, we hope to amplify ASEAN awareness and to imbue ASEAN citizens with a greater sense of regional ownership of ASEAN initiatives. In so doing, we hope to build and strengthen a collective sense of ASEAN citizenry ownership and voice to address challenges impacting the region.

Specifically, the public contribution to the ASEAN Aid will be used to underwrite the development of key ASEAN policy and project initiatives to promote and strengthen regional cooperation at the community and citizenry levels, spanning across the areas of environmental sustainability, disaster management and preparedness, education and culture, labor and governance, health and sports, gender equality and protection of vulnerable groups among others.

The proposed expert panel will comprise experts to look at key areas to assess the feasibility of ASEAN Aid, namely, financial aspects, legal, operation and evaluation, and fund-raising development and strategies, in consultation with ASEAN.
