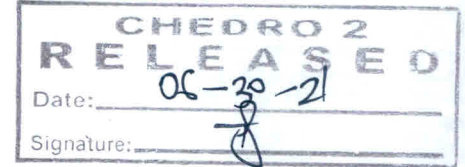

**Call for Application: SHARE Graduate Employability in ASEAN - The Contribution of Student Mobility Research Report**

The Support to Higher Education in the ASEAN Region (SHARE) Programme is the European Union's flagship higher education programme with ASEAN. The SHARE Programme has been in operation since 2015. An agreement between the European Commission and the ASEAN Secretariat has extended the Programme up to the end of December 2022. The SHARE Extension will see the programme continue its support of the ASEAN Secretariat and ASEAN stakeholders to enable greater harmonization and internationalization of ASEAN higher education. A central aim of the SHARE Programme Extension is to catalyze the transfer of ownership of programme outcomes to ASEAN entities and nominated organizations to be embedded within sustainable ASEAN-led structures and processes.

As the technical lead for Result Area 2a – Qualifications Frameworks of SHARE's programme implementation, the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) is seeking a team of researchers to conduct a qualitative study and compile a research report on graduate employability following intra-ASEAN mobility periods. This exploratory study will be conducted in support of the Master Plan on ASEAN Connectivity 2025 (MPAC 2025).
