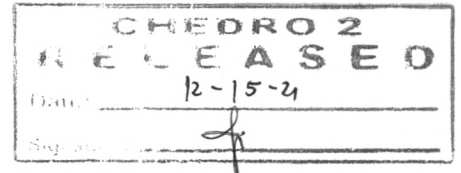

SUBJECT : CALL FOR TERTIARY EDUCATION SUBSIDY (TES) APPLICATIONS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022

DATE : December 15, 2021

Attached is a copy of the email from **ATTY. RYAN L. ESTEVEZ**, OIC-Executive Director IV, Unified Student Financial Assistance System for Tertiary Education (UniFAST), regarding the **Call for Tertiary Education Subsidy (TES) Applications for the Academic Year 2021-2022**.

As provided for by the Section 22 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 10931 or other known as the "Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Act", the TES program shall support the Tertiary Education, or any portion thereof, of Filipino students enrolled in their undergraduate post-secondary program offered in State Universities and Colleges (SUCs), Local Universities and Colleges (LUCs), and private Higher Education Institutions (PHEIs).

The prioritization for TES shall be in the following order:

1. Continuing TES grantees;
2. Students enrolled in private HEI located in municipalities or cities with no SUC or CHED-Recognized LUC; provided that, the students are residing in the municipality or city where the said private HEI is located;
3. Students who are part of households included in the Listahanan 2.0 of Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), ranked according to their estimated per capita household income; and
4. Students who are not part of the Listahanan 2.0, but qualify when ranked according to the estimated per capita household income, based on submitted documentation of income determined by the UniFAST Board.

In view thereof, HEIs are enjoined to submit their respective lists of enrolled students to the UniFAST HEI Partner's Portal (<http://www.unifast.gov.ph/system/hei-portal/>) on or before **December 31, 2021**.

Attached is the prescribed TES Template for the AY 2021-2022.

Subject : CALL FOR TERTIARY EDUCATION SUBSIDY (TES)
APPLICATIONS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022

Date : 13 December 2021

Pursuant to RA 10931 otherwise known as the "Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Act," Section 22 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), the TES program shall support the cost of tertiary education or any portion thereof, for all Filipino students enrolled in their first undergraduate post-secondary program offered in SUCs, LUCs, and private HEIs. The UniFAST Secretariat is issuing the Call for Tertiary Education Subsidy (TES) Applications for the Academic Year 2021 – 2022. TES shall be given to students in the following order and subject to availability of funds:

1. Continuing TES grantees;
2. Students enrolled in private HEI located in municipalities or cities with no SUC or CHED-recognized LUC provided that the students are residing in the municipality or city where the said private HEI is located;
3. Students who are part of households included in the Listahanan 2.0 of Department of Social Welfare and Development, ranked according to their estimated per capita household income; and
4. Students who are not part of the Listahanan 2.0, but qualify when ranked according to estimated per capita household income, based on submitted documentation of income determined by the UniFAST Board.



In view thereof, may we request the **Higher Education Institutions** to submit their respective lists of enrolled students into the UniFAST HEIs Partner's Portal (<http://www.unifast.gov.ph/system/hej-portal/>) due on or before **December 31, 2021, Friday**. The selection shall be done based on the abovementioned prioritization order, after validation and verification of supporting documentary requirements conducted by the UniFAST Regional Coordinators.

The full cooperation of Higher Education Institutions is hereby enjoined.
