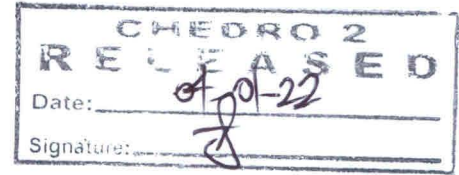

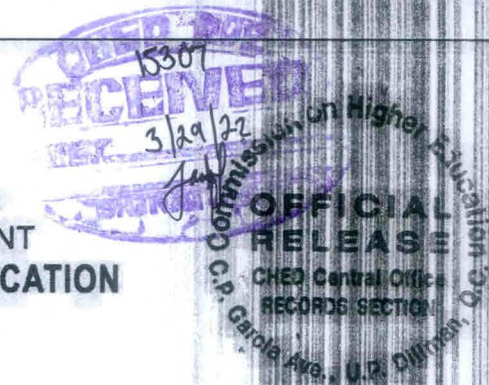

The Commission on Higher Education is pleased to inform interested parties of the call for applications for the Australia Awards Scholarship for the 2023 intake.

The Australia Awards Scholarship are prestigious international awards offered by the Australian Government to the next generation of global leaders for development. The program has two categories:

1. **Open category** - offered to Filipino leaders from both public and private sector who are interested to pursue postgraduate studies in Australia and implement a development project in the Philippines.
2. **Targeted category** - offered to Australia's key partner agencies delivering priority development initiatives.

Applicants are required to accomplish the Re-Entry Action Plan (REAP) which gives returning Filipino scholars the opportunity to use the competencies acquired in Australia to meaningful programs which will contribute to Philippine development.
