
PhilHealth Regional Office II, through the Local Health Insurance Offices (LHIOs) located in the different parts of Region 2, has responded to the call of higher education institutions (HEIs) to afford their students social health insurance as they begin to open limited face-to-face classes this school year.

For LHIO Tuguegarao City, having Cagayan Province as AOR, it caters to the most number of HEIs of Region 2 which, if translated into number of students to be registered to PhilHealth as members, would mean hundreds to thousands visiting the LHIO and the risk of students being exposed to COVID-19 virus would likely be high. To address the possible influx of students at the LHIO, we made initial visits to some tertiary schools from Tuguegarao City to Aparri, Cagayan and offered them an alternative mode of registering their students. Instead of students visiting the LHIO, it would be more efficient and safer if they submit their membership application through the school designated representative. The designated representative, after gathering the membership applications or the accomplished PhilHealth Member Registration Form (PMRF) with attachments, submits these to LHIO Tuguegarao City located at Juliana Square Bldg., Centro 4, Tuguegarao City. Transmission to the LHIO may be daily or weekly or whichever is convenient for the school. The LHIO informs the school designated representative immediately once the PhilHealth ID cards of the students are available.

We are constrained however, to visit all HEIs in Cagayan due to limited time. It is along this line that we are requesting your office to assist us in informing and encouraging all tertiary schools to adopt the alternative mode of PhilHealth registration.
