Attached for the information and participation of all interested parties is a copy of the Memorandum of CHED Chairperson Dr. J. Prospero E. De Vera III calling for applications to the abovementioned program of the ISEAS – Yusof Ishak Institute.

The WGW VFP aims to nurture the next generation of scholars and policymakers who seek to understand big-power relations and its impact on Southeast Asia. The program shall run for a period of two (2) to six (6) months and is open to pre- and post-doctoral research fellows and mid-career policymakers. Successful applicants are expected to be in residence at ISEAS and will receive a fixed monthly stipend (inclusive of a housing subsidy) for the duration of their fellowship, be entitled to round-trip economy airfare between their home base and Singapore, and may enjoy access to ISEAS facilities.
