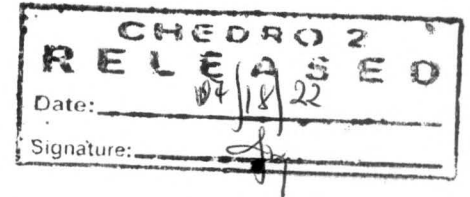

The Commission on Higher Education-International Affairs Staff (CHED-IAS) is organizing the **National Roadmap for Global Competitiveness in Communication Skills (NRGCCS) 2022 Master Teachers Training: Course for Global English Competitiveness Development** happening on 26-28 July 2022 at Mariano Marcos State University, City of Batac, Ilocos Norte.

The NRGCCS Project is an initiative envisioned to be the country's response to various challenges and opportunities concerning the country's level of English language proficiency. It aims to further develop our competitive advantage in this area to contribute to our progress towards a globally competitive knowledge economy. Part of the short-term targets of the roadmap is to further raise the level of awareness and adoption of Philippine higher education institutions to international standards and teaching techniques.

The Master Teachers Training 2022: Course for Global English Competitiveness Development is a three-day intensive master teacher training in communicative teaching with complete CFR training and orientation course for teachers and school administrators.

With this, we would like to request for your region's assistance in **inviting (2) representatives from selected institutions to join the first batch of teacher training.** The Terms of Reference for participation are as follows:

1. The 2022 Master Teacher Training is by invitation only. Each invited HEI will need to send 2 representatives to the training sessions. Representatives must have a Masters in English or a related degree with at least 5 years teaching experience.
2. Both representatives will be required to be present and complete the 3-day training session.
3. The representatives will be designated as the leads in the HEI to implement the objectives of the programme (refer to objectives)
4. Ideally, the representatives should:
 - a. have the endorsement of the university/college leadership to implement the post session requirements
 - b. have the capacity to implement the post session requirements
 - c. be physically available to attend the 3-day session
5. Training fees and materials are complimentary. Lunch and snacks will be served for the duration of the training. Travel expenses, accommodation, per diem, and other related expenses will be covered by the sending institution.
