

SUBJECT : TRAINING ON THE UNIVERSAL PREVENTION CURRICULUM (UPC) FOR SUBSTANCE USE FOR GUIDANCE COUNSELORS OF HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS IN REGION 2

DATE : SEPTEMBER 2, 2022

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994" and in support to the Executive Order No. 66, series of 2018 otherwise known as the "Institutionalizing of the Philippine Anti-Illegal Drugs Strategy (PADS)", the Commission on Higher Education Regional Office 2 will be conducting the **"Training on the Universal Prevention Curriculum (UPC) for Substance Use for Guidance Counselors of Higher Education Institutions in Region 2"** on **September 13-16, 2022** at **Isabela State University – Cauayan Campus, Cauayan City, Isabela**.

All Public and Private Higher Education Institutions in Region 2 listed in the attached list of HEIs that were not able to send representative during the same training conducted on June 15-17, 2021 for the UPC 1 and 24-25, 2021 for the UPC 2 are enjoined to send one (1) Registered Guidance Counselor (RGC) to participate in the abovementioned training. The officers of the PREACHER-02 organization are invited to participate in the said training. The food for the entire duration of the training shall be provided by CHEDRO2 while accommodation and transportation expenses to be incurred by the participants shall be charged to the local funds of their respective institution. Officials and employees of State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) who will participate in this activity should obtain prior approval from the President/Head of their respective institutions. Proper use of government funds in accordance with the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) National Budget Circular No.563 of 2016 and Budget Circular No. 2017-5 is highly expected.
