

PROVINCIAL TOURISM QUIZ BEE

GUIDELINES, RULES AND REGULATIONS September 14, 2022 at 1:00 in the afternoon Main Atruim, Robinsons Place, Tuguegarao City

- 1. Participants should come from Top ten (10) performing schools in the Junior High School level per Congressional District of the Province, based on the certification of the Department of Education.
- 2. Participating public and private collegiate schools in the province certified by Commission on Higher Education (CHED) will participate in the contest. For the Tertiary Quiz Bee, the participants must be a student of a Tourism Course as proven by their enrollment slip.
- 3. Each participating school both public and private shall composed of a student and one faculty coach.
- 4. Only currently enrolled undergraduate Junior Secondary and Tourism tertiary students are allowed to participate in the contest. They must present their valid ID cards upon registration.
- 5. Only the faculty coach may act as a spokesperson for the contestant during the contest proper.
- The following topics will be the scope of the Quiz Bee.
 A. Trivia questions covering tourism, current events and general knowledge
- 7. The following question types is given:
 A. Questions will be identification, true or false, fill- in the blank and multiple choice type where the contestant are to write completely and legibly the answer to the questions.
 B. In addition, each question shall be given a time limit of ten (10) seconds for easy, fifteen (15) seconds for average and twenty (20) seconds for difficult.
- 8. A total of 15 questions shall be given in the Quiz Bee. Divided into three rounds of 5 questions each with Easy-1 point, Average-2 points, difficult-3 points. In case of a tie, a clincher question/s shall be asked to determine the winner.
- 9. An official quizmaster will read the type, credit points, time limits and give signal for the teams to click on the question. The question shall be read twice. Timing will begin only after the second reading of the question.
- 10. Contestants must write legibly their answer on provided boards and must present their answer before the end of the time limit. Otherwise, they shall be considered as having no answer to the question.
- 11. After the time limit, each contestant shall raise their respective boards and the correct answer shall read by the quizmaster for the information of the contestants and the audience. Each presented answer should be checked by the board of judges. The board will declare the contestants which got the correct answer.
- 12. Any protest or inquiry from the contestants regarding the answer must be made prior to the reading of the next question, otherwise the Board of Judges will entertain no more protests or inquiries pertaining to the said question.
- 13. The quiz bee organizers reserve the right to eject any participant or member of the audience who they believe is detrimental to the orderly conduct of the contest.
- 14. The decision of the Board of Judges on any protest or inquiry shall be considered final and not subject to appeal.
