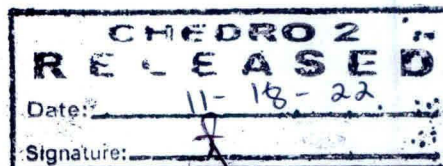

The Commission is pleased to invite all Philippine higher education institutions (HEIs) to participate in the **ANTENA Final Conference: Strengthening Policies and Partnerships for the Internationalization of Education in Philippine HEIs** to be held on 22-23 November 2022. As a hybrid event, the conference will happen on-site at De La Salle University in Taft Avenue, Manila and will also be open to online participants via Zoom.

Under the Internationalization of Higher Education in the Philippines Network ("ANTENA") Project, the Commission joins 10 Philippine universities and three (3) European institutions in nationwide efforts to 1) improve the country's credit recognition, mobility system, and international research activities, as well as 2) develop specialized staff in international relations. Launched in 2019, the project will end this December 2022.

During the Training of Trainors Conference held in Baguio City on 11-15 July 2022, the Philippine Internationalization Network (PHL IN-NET) was launched through the signing of its Letter of Cooperation by the project's consortium members which thereafter became the network's pioneer member institutions. Taking off from the launching, a final conference will be held with the following objectives:

- Present the outputs accomplished and outcomes achieved by the ANTENA Project
- Introduce the PHL IN-NET and discuss the expansion of its membership
- Promote the International Relations Office (IRO) services created and/or improved
- Promote the sustainability of ANTENA's results through the support and strengthening of the PHL IN-NET



Philippine HEIs are encouraged to participate in this conference, which will be held free of charge. Interested participants are requested to register through the link <https://bit.ly/ANTENAFinalConference> to confirm their participation online or in-person.

Due to the limited number of slots available, participants will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. The Commission also strongly encourages participants to commit the time to be present for the full duration of the conference. Attendance shall be monitored for the issuance of the certificates of participation.
