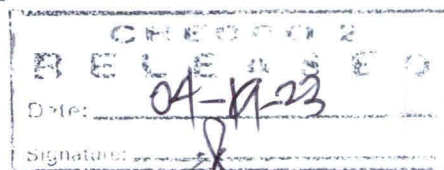

- Filipino national of legal age
- Director, officer or employee of a business organization preferably with national or region-wide coverage and must be duly registered or licensed to do business in the Philippines.
- Engaged in a combination of at least five years ongoing or completed projects, involving programs or activities related to the private sector or nationwide business innovation, investment, funding or capital ventures, or technology adoption and commercialization.
- Not holding any elective or appointive position in any government agency.
- Demonstrates high personal and professional integrity and have relevant knowledge, skills, expertise and ability to make sound judgment, and
- Capable and competent to participate in the NIC meetings and activities.

- ✓ Published scholar or author in science, technology, and innovation
- ✓ Demonstrates high personal and professional integrity and have relevant knowledge, skills, expertise, and ability to make sound judgment; and
- ✓ Capable and competent to participate in the NIC meetings and activities.

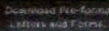



Action Requested. NIC-Executive Technical Board members' dissemination of the attached publicity materials for the subject call for nominations.

Background.

1. Pursuant to Section 6 of Republic Act No. 11293 otherwise known as the Philippine Innovation Act, the creation of the National Innovation Council (NIC) comprising 18 *ex officio* members from national government agencies shall include seven (7) Executive Members from the ranks of business, MSME, academe, and the scientific community. The inclusion of the Executive Members will ensure sectoral representation in the development of the policies and programs for improving the country's innovation governance.
2. Following the provisions of the law, the NIC Secretariat began its call for nominations from 11 October to 10 November 2022. The nominees, upon evaluation of the NIC-Executive Technical Board, were endorsed to the NIC for further vetting and review as approved via NIC-ETB Resolution No. 01, Series of 2023 dated 24 January 2023.
3. During the 4th NIC Meeting on 21 February 2023, the NIC agreed to endorse the top 6 Executive Member nominees to the Office of the President (OP) for appointment and instructed the NIC Secretariat to commence another call for nominations for a **Climate Change Expert** to serve as the 7th

Executive Member. This is in consideration of the importance of climate change and its impact on innovations and sustainability.

4. In view thereof, the NIC Secretariat is requesting NIC member agencies to disseminate the information and promotion materials on the call for nomination in your respective websites, email networks, social media, and other platforms you may deem appropriate, particularly to organizations dealing with environment and/or climate change concerns. The call for nominations shall be from **27 March 2023** to **14 April 2023**.
