The Commission on Higher Education hereby informs all interested parties of the launch of the 2024 Call for Proposals under the Erasmus+ Programme offered by the European Union.

The Erasmus+ is the Union Programme for education, training, youth and sport covering the period 2021-2027. Building on the success of the programme in the 2014-2020 period, Erasmus+ intensifies its initiatives expanding opportunities for a wider range of participants and organizations to foster a more inclusive and unified, greener and technologically adept society.

This call for proposals covers the following Key Actions of the Erasmus+ Programme:

- International Credit Mobility (ICM) The ICM supports the mobility of student and staff enrolled or employed at a higher education institution (HEI) through a study period or traineeship abroad, which is included in the student's study programme to complete a degree.
- 2. Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJM) (Funded under Key Action 2 (KA2): Cooperation Among Organizations and Institutions) The EMJM is a prestigious, integrated transnational study programmes at Master level lasting between one and two years, delivered by an international consortium of higher education institutions (HEIs), and if fitting, with other educational and/or non-educational partners with relevant expertise and aptitude in the subject areas or fields of expertise.

The EMJM aims to elevate the attractiveness and excellence of European Higher Education and to draw talents to Europe through institutional academic cooperation and individual mobility for students in the EMJM programme, with EU-funded scholarship scholarship grants for the best applicants.

3. Erasmus Mundus Design Measures (EMDM) (Funded under Key Action 2 (KA2): Cooperation Among Organizations and Institutions) - The EMDM support the improvement of the capacities of universities to modernize and internationalize their curricula and teaching practices, pool resources, and establish common mechanisms among higher education systems for accreditation, quality assurance, and recognition of degrees and credits, by maximizing opportunities offered by the European Approach for Quality Assurance of Joint Programmes.

The EMDM aims to support the development of new, innovative, excellent, integrated transnational study programmes at Master level.

- 4. Capacity Building in Higher Education (CBHE) (Funded under Key Action 2 (KA2): Cooperation Among Organizations and Institutions) The CBHE supports international cooperation projects based on multilateral partnerships between organizations actively involved in higher education, intending to support the relevance, quality, modernisation and responsiveness of higher education.
- 5. Jean Monnet Actions (JMA) in the Field of Higher Education (Funded under Key Action 3 (KA3) Support to Policy Development and Cooperation) The JMA in the field of higher education supports Higher Education Institutions worldwide in advancing research and teaching on European Union studies as well as policy discussions and interactions between academics and policy makers on Union policy priorities.
